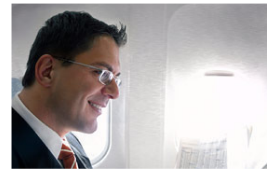
Daily, from Athens and Thessaloniki to Vienna

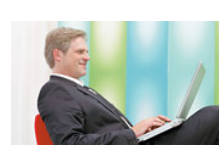
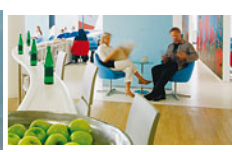
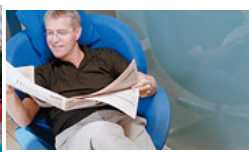


Business Lounge in Vienna for everyone!
